

How to Apply for Supportive Housing Services

Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village is funded to provide Supportive Housing Services to seniors who reside in the rental and life lease apartments or bungalows.

Supportive Housing Services applications are available by contacting the Manager, Supportive Housing Services at Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village. Referrals are accepted from anyone. Once a referral has been made, the Manager will visit you in your home to assess service eligibility, requirements, and the desired times to receive Supportive Housing Services.

- Life Lease Housing
- Long-Term Care
- Supportive Housing Services
- Various recreational, social, and spiritual activities
- Satellite Meal Service (frozen home-cooked meals delivered to your home)

Supportive Housing Program



Recognizing seniors' rights and abilities to:

- control one's own life
- make decisions and choices
- assume responsibilities for one's own actions
- live with participation and equality within our community

The Supportive Housing Program at Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village provides the physical assistance required by seniors to do everyday activities. The person requiring the service requests and directs the services. Seniors who are eligible for such services determine what assistance is required, how it should be provided, and when it is needed.

Funding for the Supportive Housing Program is negotiated with LHIN 4 (Local Health Integration Network). The total hours of service for all program participants must be met within the approved budget.

Eligibility

To be eligible to receive Supportive Housing Services the applicant should be:

- a resident of Ontario
- insured under the Insurance Act of Ontario
- safe in their own home when left unattended
- able to direct their own personal support and homemaking services
- determined through participation in assessment to be physically unable to safely complete the routine activities of living within a reasonable time
- able to have necessary medical needs met by the existing community health care network

Supportive Housing Services at Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village are provided in a manner that recognizes individuals and responds to a person's needs and preferences.



Services Available

The Supportive Housing Program provides non-medical assistance with the activities of daily living and can include assistance with any or all of the following activities:

- personal grooming and hygiene
- bathing or showering
- dressing and undressing
- toileting
- rising and retiring
- meal preparation and assistance with eating
- positioning and transferring
- housekeeping and laundry
- medical procedures as deemed appropriate by a professional community health care provider

As determined by needs, services are available on a scheduled and on-call basis 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Additional services to sustain substantial caregiving of an aging spouse are negotiated on an "as needed" basis.

Employees who have successfully completed the Health Care Aide or Personal Support Worker Program provide services.
