Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village is funded to provide Supportive Housing Services to seniors who reside in the rental and life lease apartments or bungalows at Ina Grafton.

Supportive Housing Services applications are available by contacting the Assistant Manager, Supportive Housing Services who will visit you in your home to assess service eligibility, and the type of services to be provided.

- Satellite Meal Service (frozen home-cooked meals delivered to your home)

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## Supportive Housing Program



Our Supportive Housing Program at Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village recognizes seniors' rights and abilities to:

- control one's own life
- make decisions and choices
- assume responsibilities for one's own actions
- live with participation and equality within our community

Our program provides physical assistance to seniors so they can carry out their activities of daily living. The person requiring the service requests and directs the services. Seniors who are eligible for services help determine what assistance is required, how it should be provided, and when it is needed.

Funding for the Supportive Housing Program is provided with the Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant LHIN (Local Health Integration Network).

## Eligibility

To be eligible to receive Supportive Housing Services, the applicant should be:

- a resident of Ontario
- insured under the Insurance Act of Ontario
- safe in his/her own home when left unattended
- able to direct his/her own personal support and homemaking services
- determined through participation in assessment to be physically unable to safely complete the routine activities of daily living within a reasonable time
- able to have necessary medical needs met by the existing community health care network

Supportive Housing Services at Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village are provided by Personal Support Workers in a manner that recognizes individuals and responds to a person's needs and preferences.

## Services Available

The Supportive Housing Program provides non-medical assistance with the activities of daily living and can include assistance with any or all of the following activities:

- personal grooming and hygiene
- bathing or showering
- dressing and undressing
- toileting
- rising and retiring
- meal preparation and assistance with eating
- positioning and transferring
- medical procedures as deemed appropriate by a professional community health care provider

As determined by needs, services are available on a scheduled and on-call basis 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Additional services to sustain substantial care giving of an aging spouse are negotiated on an 'as needed' basis.
