SMS stands for Satellite Meal Service. Frozen home-cooked meals may be delivered to you, weekly, for storage in your home freezer.

Meals are delivered to your home every Monday between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

Each meal comes with heating instructions and is oven-ready for your microwave, toaster oven, or regular oven.

This service will enable those it serves to remain more independent in their own homes.
