2.0 RESPONSIBLE TO

3.0 POSITION SUMMARY

Report to Manager, Food and Environmental Services. Perform a variety of food services duties related to the preparation and serving of food at Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village.

4.0 ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- .1 Set and clear tables.
- .2 Arrange and deliver prepared food to tables; serve meals.
- .3 Store food services supplies and linens.
- .4 Wash and disinfect tables, chairs, cupboards, counters, walls, and food carts in kitchen and serving areas.
- Operate, clean, and disinfect equipment such as meat slicer, deep fat fryer, steamer, blender, microwave, coffee machine, food grinder, garbage pails, and food containers.
- .6 Sweep and wash floors in kitchen, dishroom, and serving areas.
- .7 Disassemble, clean, disinfect, and reassemble dishwashing machine.
- .8 Clean, disinfect, and stock walk-in fridge, freezer and storage facilities.
- .9 Dispose garbage.
- .10 Train new Dietary staff.
- .11 Assist in the preparation of food for regular and modified diets, resident nourishments, special functions, non-resident meals and snacks.
- .12 Respond to emergency evacuations by transporting able and disabled persons.

REVIEWED:	

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- .13 Portion Meals on Wheels foods according to menu specifications.
- .14 Performs other duties as assigned which are directly related to the major responsibilities of the job.

5.0 ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS

- .1 Able to work in an area where the temperatures can change drastically.
- .2 Able to walk on different floor surfaces safely.
- .3 Exposure to unpredictable resident behaviour.
- .4 Exposure to plants, cleaning agents, etc.

6.0 PHYSICAL DEMANDS

- .1 Constant (67 100% of shift) standing and walking.
- .2 Occasional (0-33% of shift) inanimate lifting up to 50 pounds, carrying, wrist motion, crouching, reaching above/below shoulder, reaching backward.

7.0 QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

- .1 Dietary Aide Certificate.
- .2 Safe Food Handler's Certificate (completed every five years).
- .3 Grade twelve (12) Diploma.
- .4 Ability to read and understand written and verbal instructions in English, independently.
- .5 Demonstrate excellent interpersonal skills.
- .6 Be able to physically perform the duties and responsibilities assigned.
