

## Assisted Living Program

The Assisted Living Program at Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village recognizes seniors' rights and abilities to:

- control their own life
- make decisions and choices
- assume responsibilities for their actions
- live with participation and equality within our community

The program provides physical assistance to seniors so they can carry out their activities of daily living. The person requiring the service requests and directs the services. Seniors who are eligible for services help determine what assistance is required, how it should be provided and when it is needed.

Funding for the Assisted Living Program is provided by the Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant Local Health Integration Network (LHIN).

## Eligibility

To be eligible to receive Assisted Living Services, the applicant should be:

- a resident of Ontario
- insured under the Insurance Act of Ontario
- safe in their own home when left unattended
- able to direct their own personal support and homemaking services
- be physically unable to safely complete the routine activities of daily living within a reasonable time as determined through participation in an assessment
- able to have necessary medical needs met by the existing community health care networks

Assisted Living Services at Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village are provided by Personal Support Workers in a manner that recognizes individuals and responds to a person's needs and preferences.

## Services Available

The Assisted Living Program provides non-medical assistance with the activities of daily living and can include assistance with any or all of the following activities:

- personal grooming and hygiene
- bathing or showering
- dressing and undressing
- toileting
- rising and retiring
- light meal preparation and escort to and from dining room
- positioning and transferring
- medical procedures as deemed appropriate by a professional community health care provider
- medication assistance program

As determined by needs, services are available on a scheduled and on-call basis 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Additional services to sustain substantial care giving of an aging spouse are negotiated on an 'as needed' basis.

## How to Apply

Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village is funded to provide Assisted Living Services to seniors who reside in NIGGV's rental and life lease apartments or bungalows.

Assisted Living Services applications are available by contacting the Client Coordinator, Assisted Living Services who will visit you in your home to assess service eligibility and the type of services to be provided.

Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village provides:

- Rental Housing
- Life Lease Housing
- Long-Term Care
- Various recreational, social, and spiritual activities
- Satellite Meal Service (frozen home-cooked meals delivered to your home)
- Recreational facilities
