

Welcome to Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village!

As a not-for-profit, charitable organization and provider of services to seniors in the Niagara Region for over 50 years, Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village encompasses two sites - St. Catharines and Niagara-on-the-Lake. Operating since 1959, the Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village site is located on Linwell Road in the north end of St. Catharines. The Niagara-on-the-Lake site, known as Stone Road Village, opened in 2012 and is located on Hunter Road at the corner of Niagara Stone Road.

Facilities at these two sites house over 500 seniors. At Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village, seniors live either in rental or rent-geared-to-income apartments, life lease bungalows or apartments, bedsitter rooms or long-term care (nursing home). At Stone Road Village, life lease apartments are available for active seniors 55+.

The Foundation's History

NIGG Village operates under a volunteer Board of Directors and receives funding from various government ministries, but it cannot solely depend on these sources. Thus, the NIGG Foundation, with its own volunteer Board of Directors, was formed in 2000 to aid with fundraising efforts at the Village. The Foundation funds projects that benefit the residents of Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village by providing them with an exceptional place to live and call 'home'.

Mission

The Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Foundation is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for seniors of Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village.

Goals

- To identify fundraising opportunities that are not routinely funded by budget provisions, e.g. capital improvements, amenities.
- To conduct annual fundraising drives to achieve our goal of enhancing the quality of life for our residents.
- To invest in projects which will sustain the future of Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village.
- To work with the Niagara Ina Grafton Gage Village Board of Directors, Management and Residents to prioritize fundraising needs.
